About the Meisner Technique

One of 3 major methods of acting today, it was created by Sanford Meisner, an actor and teacher at The Group Theatre and Neighborhood Playhouse in New York. The goal of the Meisner technique has often been described as getting actors to "live truthfully under imaginary circumstances." Larry Silverberg, Director of the True Acting Institute U.S. and Europe, was a student of Meisner and is considered the world's foremost teacher and author on the approach. Prominent actors who studied with Meisner include Sandra Bullock, Gregory Peck, Grace Kelly, Robert Duvall, Diane Keaton, James Caan, and Sydney Pollack.

Marsha presently teaches acting at the Hochschule für Musik in Nürnberg, Germany. She received her Bachelor of Arts in Dramatic Arts at Mills College in California and also studied acting in Germany. Marsha became both a certified Meisner teacher at the True Acting Institute with Larry Silverberg as well as a designated Linklater voice teacher in 2003. She also trained with Ned Mandarino, an original member of the Actor's Studio Directors Unit. Marsha acts throughout Europe on stage, film, television and radio. She also conducts workshops and seminars around the world on topics such as acting, voice and stress, public speaking, text interpretation, personal expression, stage presence, overcoming stage fright, auditioning, and releasing your creative potential.
